

ROAD CLOSURES/DELAYS

CLOSURES:

HOMEWARD AVENUE from Highway #33 N. to Southwood Drive will be closed from April 19 to April 30 for road reconstruction.

SOUTHWOOD DRIVE from Fairleigh Street East to Homeward Avenue will be closed from April 19 to May 14 for road reconstruction.

KING STREET from Barrack Street to Place D'Armes will be closed April 20 for events at the K-Rock Centre.

MACDONNELL STREET from Union Street to Hill Street will be closed for construction until April 26.

PRINCESS STREET is now closed from Wellington Street to just above Ontario Street and King Street is closed from Brock Street through the intersection at Princess Street.

DELAYS:

CREEKFORD ROAD between Bayridge Drive (future extension) and Cloggs Road will be reduced to one lane until the end of May during the installation of a trunk watermain.

PRINCESS STREET will be reduced to one lane from Collins Bay Road to Westbrook Road until mid July.

MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION ROAD WORK:

HIGHWAY 401 EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND SHOULDERS will be closed for temporary access and egress, maintenance and layout.

HIGHWAY 401 EASTBOUND BETWEEN SYDENHAM ROAD AND DIVISION STREET will be reduced to one lane daily from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

HIGHWAY 401 WESTBOUND BETWEEN MONTREAL STREET AND DIVISION STREET will be reduced to one lane daily from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

DIVISION STREET AT HIGHWAY 401 will be closed for up to 15 minutes every hour from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Wednesday, April 14. If inclement weather occurs, the closure will take place on Thursday, April 15. **DIVISION STREET AT HIGHWAY 401 WILL BE REDUCED TO ONE LANE** in both directions daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

SYDENHAM ROAD AT HIGHWAY 401 will be reduced to one lane in both directions daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

HIGHWAY 401 EASTBOUND OFF RAMP AT SIR JOHN A MACDONALD BOULEVARD will be closed daily from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

OVERNIGHT LANE RESTRICTIONS ON THE LASALLE CAUSEWAY NOVEMBER 2009 – MAY 2010
