

## ROAD CLOSURES/DELAYS

### CLOSURES:

**HILL STREET** from MacDonnell Street to Napier Street will be closed until mid May 2010 for road reconstruction.

**HOMEWARD AVENUE** from Highway #33 N. to Southwood Drive will be closed until the end of April for road reconstruction.

**HOMEWARD AVENUE** from Southwood Drive to MacClement Drive will be closed from May 3 until the end of May for road reconstruction.

**MACDONNELL STREET** from Union Street to Hill Street will be closed for reconstruction until the end of April.

**ONTARIO STREET** from Johnson Street to West Street will be closed on May 2 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for the Battle of the Atlantic Parade and memorial service.

**PRINCESS STREET** is closed from Wellington Street to just above Ontario Street and King Street is closed from Brock Street through the intersection at Princess Street for reconstruction.

**SOUTHWOOD DRIVE** from Fairleigh Street East to Homeward Avenue will be closed until mid May for road reconstruction.

### DELAYS:

**CREEKFORD ROAD** between Bayridge Drive (future extension) and Cloggs Road will be reduced to one lane until the end of May during the installation of a trunk watermain.

**PRINCESS STREET** will be reduced to one lane from Collins Bay Road to Westbrook Road until mid July for bridge maintenance.

### MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION ROAD WORK:

**HIGHWAY 401 EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND SHOULDERS** will be closed for temporary access and egress, maintenance and layout.

**HIGHWAY 401 EASTBOUND BETWEEN SYDENHAM ROAD AND DIVISION STREET** will be reduced to one lane daily from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

**HIGHWAY 401 WESTBOUND BETWEEN MONTREAL STREET AND DIVISION STREET** will be reduced to one lane daily from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

**DIVISION STREET AT HIGHWAY 401** will be reduced to one lane in both directions daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**SYDENHAM ROAD AT HIGHWAY 401** will be reduced to one lane in both directions daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**HIGHWAY 401 EASTBOUND OFF RAMP AT SIR JOHN A MACDONALD BOULEVARD** will be closed daily from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**HIGHWAY 401 WESTBOUND OFF RAMP AT DIVISION STREET** will be closed daily from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**SIR JOHN A. MACDONALD BOULEVARD AT HIGHWAY 401** will be reduced to one lane in both directions daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

### OVERNIGHT LANE RESTRICTIONS ON THE LASALLE CAUSEWAY NOVEMBER 2009 – MAY 2010

#### Unusable items and garbage

Unusable items and garbage can be disposed of at the:

Waste Management transfer station at 62 St. Remy Place  
(off Dalton Avenue), from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.,  
Monday to Friday and 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturdays.

The Kingston East Landfill site is also open Tuesday through Saturday, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Disposal fees apply at both locations.

For other waste removal services, please check the Yellow Pages of the local phone book or the classified section of a local newspaper.

#### Bagged garbage

**Place up to two bags of garbage at curbside** on your usual collection day. Additional bagged garbage will be collected if it is tagged. Garbage tags are \$2 each and can be purchased at City Hall and the AMS office at Queen's University. ### Moving?

### Remember to close your Utilities Kingston account.

If you are moving, contact Utilities Kingston as soon as possible to set-up or finalize your account. A minimum of five business days' notice is necessary to ensure your utility services are set-up or finalized on the date requested. To avoid delays, it is necessary for the account holder or a representative to be at the service address if the meters are not accessible from the outside.

The only person authorized to make any changes to the account is the person whose name appears on the bill. If your name appears on the bill, you are considered fully responsible for the account until your cancellation request is received and processed.

### Bylaw enforcement reminder

### Illegal disposal penalties range up to \$5,000

Property owners, landlords, and tenants are reminded of three bylaws in place to keep the City clean of garbage and debris.

#### Illegal Disposal Bylaws

The yards bylaw prohibits anyone from using any land or structure within the City to dispose of garbage, refuse, industrial and domestic waste. Domestic waste includes items such as refrigerators, stoves, furniture, and paper. Anyone throwing, placing or depositing debris on any private or municipal property within the City can be charged under a second bylaw that covers **illegal dumping**. Both these bylaws carry a penalty of up to \$5,000. The **waste collection bylaw** and streets bylaw also prescribe penalties for strewn garbage and littering.

The City is moving towards more stringent enforcement and will issue orders, and/or move directly to charges against property owners in violation of these bylaws. While property owners are responsible for maintaining their properties, landlords must also work with tenants to ensure debris is not left at the property.

Additionally, should debris be left at the property an administration fee of \$125 and the cost of clean-up will be applied to the property tax bill.
