

Section 1: Long Term Care Nurse Call System

The Austco Nurse Call Long Term Care solution for Extendicare Canada is tailored to the specific needs of your facilities while meeting the goals of improving resident care, increasing staff efficiency and reducing costs.

1. The resident call stations in the rooms will include a green “CALL” button and a pendant socket with a call cord.

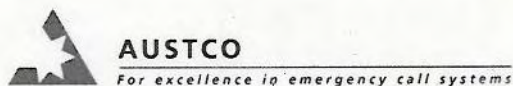
- Each station has a large green “CALL” button, “Cancel” button and a pendant socket with a call cord. The station is wired to a Room Controller located in the corridors on each floor.
- A resident call is created when the green button on the pendant is pressed, the green “CALL” button on the front of the station is activated, or the call cord is removed. The red reassurance LED will light up behind the “Cancel” button once a call has been activated and will remain lit until the call has been cancelled.
- The call button features soft touch, back-lit push button manufactured from silicon rubber with anti-bacterium additive as an infection control measure.
- Resident call stations are flush wall mountable and are installed in a standard single-gang boxes.



2. Washrooms will be fitted with one standard pull cord station

- The washroom stations are waterproof and come equipped with a Green or Red Mylar pull cord. A washroom call is generated by pulling the pull cord. Upon activation of the pull cord, a washroom call will be placed on the system indicating where the call was activated. This call can only be cancelled at the point of origin.
- Washroom stations will be installed in a standard single-gang wall box.





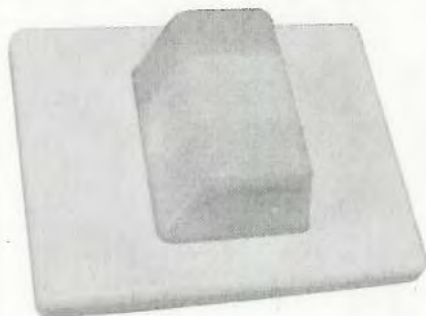
3. Lounges, Activity Rooms and Dining Rooms will be equipped with an Emergency Station. The Emergency Call Stations are attractive, robust and easy to use.

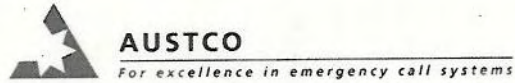
- Each station has a large red “EMERGENCY” button and a “Cancel” button. The station is wired to a local controller on each floor.
- An Emergency call is created when the red “EMERGENCY” button on the front of the station is activated. The red reassurance LED will light up behind the “Cancel” button once the call is activated. Calls must be cancelled at the point of origin and cannot be cancelled at the nursing station.
- The call button features a soft touch, back-lit push button manufactured from silicon rubber with anti-bacterium additive as an infection control measure.



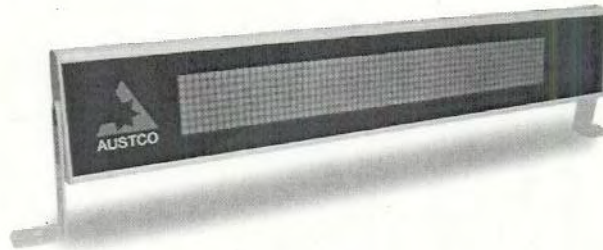
4. Resident Suites, Public Washroom and Local Areas will be outfitted with one dome light in the corridor outside of the room or in a specific location area.

- Over door lights will be mounted in the ceiling or above the doors to the room|
- Dome lights will provide high intensity Red, Green and Yellow LEDS combined with customizable steady or flashing rates to indicate call type priorities.





5. The Austco Nurse Station Annunciators will provide audio and visual annunciation of active Nurse Call alarms
- 12 character backlit LCD scrolling display
 - Three colour LED's to indicate call priorities
 - Day / Night Modes



6. The entire Austco Nurse Call system will be powered using a PSA-10 power supplies with battery backup.
- The PSA-10 provides two resettable fused and individual switch 4 amp power outputs. The power output switches are key switch protected.
 - Incorporates internal or optional external 12 volt battery back-up.
