### Changes to Homeless Priority on the wait list for Rent-Geared-to-Income (RGI) housing for

#### The City of Kingston and County of Frontenac

Effective **January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015**, the Homeless Priority on the centralized wait list for Rent-Geared-to-Income (RGI) Assistance and managed by The Social Housing Registry, 362 Montreal Street, Kingston, will no longer be available to applicants.

The City of Kingston, as Service Manager is implementing a new “homeless services” delivery system as a result of the Council approved 10 Year Housing & Homelessness Plan. One of the approved recommendations in the Plan was to remove the Homeless Priority from the wait list and provide alternate supports and services for homeless individuals.

If you are homeless at this time, please call or visit one of the **Housing & Homelessness Help Programs** listed below, to meet with a worker. Together, you will explore your homeless circumstances to see if you may be eligible for services under the new homeless services delivery system.
