In accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, the information contained in the Nomination Form is deemed to be a public record and may be inspected by any person at the Office of the City Clerk during regular business hours. Third Party Advertiser contact information will be posted on the City of Kingston's official election website, <http://www.cityofkingston.ca/city-hall/elections>. Third Party Advertisers are hereby requested to authorize the release of such information.
