



CLEAN MARINE POLICY 2018

Confederation Basin Marina and Portsmouth Olympic Harbour

As a client of the City of Kingston I, _____, confirm that I have read, am familiar with, and fully agree with the City of Kingston's Clean Marina Policy. I will comply with the Clean Marine Policy and help protect our natural environment.

I commit my guests, my crew and myself:

- 1) To keep all refuse and garbage of any kind on board the boat until we are able to place it in the waste containers on shore.
- 2) To separate all recyclables and place them in the appropriate containers.
- 3) To separate hazardous wastes and dispose of them in accordance with marina guidelines or take them to the municipal household hazardous waste collection site. Hazardous items include, but are not limited to: oils, antifreeze, batteries, paints, solvents, cleaners, and fuel.
- 4) To take all necessary steps to avoid spilling fuel (fueling at the dock is prohibited), oil, chemicals, or any cleaners whatsoever into the water, and to refrain from pumping oil-contaminated bilge water overboard.
- 5) To carry out repair work on the boat in designated areas only, taking all precautions required by the City of Kingston to avoid leaving any debris, litter, solid or liquid contaminants on the ground.
- 6) To make all efforts to contain paint from sanding or scraping projects. Paint scrapings will be captured by a ground cloth. Paint dust will be captured through the use of a dustless sander using a vacuum and filter attachment. Paint refuse will then be double plastic bagged and disposed of in the garbage dumpster (not in garbage cans).
- 7) To never discharge raw sewage from the black-water holding tanks anywhere other than an approved pump-out facility.
- 8) To avoid pumping grey water overboard while docking in the marina and to use the onshore washroom facilities whenever practical.
- 9) To conserve water by using an automatic shutoff nozzle when filling or washing the boat.

- 10) To use environmentally-friendly products (such as Eco Logo products) whenever and wherever possible.
- 11) To operate the boat in a safe and considerate manner at all times, to operate the engines only when necessary and to avoid creating a wake when entering and leaving the marina.
- 12) To always show respect for the environment and for the fish, birds, animals, and all other creatures that share it with us.
- 13) To never feed wild animals, including but not limited to, ducks and geese, per City of Kingston By-Law 2009-76.
