He served as president of the Ontario Classical Association. In 2000 he joined eleven other prominent Canadians as a founding member of the Canadian Committee for the Restitution of the Parthenon Marbles. At the community level he was active in St Georges Cathedral and the Marine Museum of the Great Lakes. He will be remembered for a delightful sense of humour, a contagious enthusiasm and, an ever smiling face.
