City of Kingston Winter Services Response Plan *Revised 02/13/2025

Effective December 1, 2024 - March 31, 2025

The 2024/2025 Winter Services Response Plan outlines the services available within the City of Kingston to support people experiencing homelessness during the winter season. It is designed to adapt and evolve based on demand and availability of appropriate locations.

The Winter Services Response Plan includes:

- Locations offering emergency beds and overnight services including summaries of services offered and hours of operation
- Weekday and Weekend Daytime Drop in Services
- Warming Centres
- Street Outreach Services and Prevention Diversion Services

Emergency Shelter Beds/ Overnight Services

Note: this plan reflects maximum shelter capacity – meaning the total number of individuals that can be supported on-site. This varies from the number of beds available as some sites support couples and families who can share beds in some locations. If each bed is occupied by only one individual, then the number of beds is equal to the minimum capacity of the site.
